Christina’s cheerful personality and dedication won over customers and staff alike, leading her manager to offer her a permanent role stocking shelves and assisting with other tasks. While she cherished her time at Cracker Barrel, limited hours motivated Christina and her coach to seek new opportunities, ultimately leading her to a seven-year tenure at Skyline Chili, where she was known for her hard work and commitment.

A significant life change came in December 2023, when Christina moved to Alexandria, KY. Through the assistance of the Supported Community Living Waiver, she joined the New Perceptions Work Center. Now, Christina works with a team of supportive peers and staff, achieving a sense of accomplishment and stability.
